

Student Expectations/Rules

for 1:1 Student Chromebook Use

- ✚ Take great care of **your assigned Chromebook**
 - Treat Chromebook gently, inside & out.
 - Keep Chromebook clean and free of marks
 - Do not drop or slam Chromebook on desk
 - Do not place anything heavy on top of Chromebook.
 - Tell teacher immediately if you notice damage or marks on your assigned Chromebook
 - At the end of the day... put your Chromebook away properly
 - Close the lid when walking between classes or when in the hallway.
 - Do not run or play while holding Chromebook.
 - Carry the Chromebook **properly**
 - Do not carry the Chromebook by the lid (the screen can easily crack)
**IF YOU CHOOSE TO CARRY YOUR CHROMEBOOK BY THE LID
ANYWAY ...AFTER UNDERSTANDING THAT THIS IS NOT THE PROPER
WAY TO CARRY YOUR CHROMEBOOK ...AND THE SCREEN CRACKS...
YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE ANOTHER CHROMEBOOK UNTIL YOUR
PARENT SIGNS AND RETURNS A LETTER TO SCHOOL THAT YOUR
TEACHER WILL SEND HOME)**

- ✚ Always log off of your Chromebook when not using it.

- ✚ DO NOT share your password with anyone.

- ✚ DO NOT USE A CHROMEBOOK THAT **DOES NOT HAVE YOUR NAME ON IT**
WITHOUT YOUR TEACHER'S PERMISSION

- ✚ ONLY go to websites that are allowed by your teacher
 - If you DO KNOW which websites are okay... ask your teacher.

Misuses of Chromebook (Inappropriate use or handling)

- ✚ Intentionally causing damage to your assigned Chrome Book
- ✚ Causing damage to another student's Chrome Book
- ✚ Going to inappropriate websites
- ✚ Running while carrying
- ✚ Carrying by the lid
- ✚ Laying heavy objects on top of
- ✚ Removing label off of
- ✚ Writing or marking on
- ✚ Removing keys from the Chrome Book's keypad
- ✚ Dropping Chromebook on desk
- ✚ Using someone else's Chromebook without teacher's permission
- ✚ Not following teacher's directions when using
- ✚ Leaving in desk or locker (not returning to classroom storage area)

➤ Consequences for misuse or rules violation

➤ **Teacher will take your chrome book**

➤ **Teacher will contact your parent**
